CONNECT – Announcements (page 2) & Building Relationships

- 1. Is there anything noteworthy that is going on in your life since last week? Where have you seen God at work in your life or the lives of others since we last met?
- 2. What's the most funny or memorable experience you can recall when you lost something? What did it take for you to find what was lost, and what did you learn about yourself in the process?

REFLECT - Out of the Word and Into Our Lives

- 3. From a fresh reading of John 10:22-42 [read it together], what's one thing that speaks to you in your current walk?
- 4. What's one thing from this week's sermon that you hope we talk about as a group?
- 5. The Jews claim to be in suspense about His identity in verse 24, yet they reject Him when He speaks. When sharing Christ with others, how can you tell the difference between an individual who is truly wrestling with legitimate doubts and an individual who is stubborn in the suspense of disbelief?
- 6. How should the truth of verses 28-29 and the idea that believers are secure in sovereign hands impact the way we live out our faith?
- 7. How can you respond to the lies of Satan that your guilt is too great for God to forgive?
- 8. Compare John 10:30 ("I and the Father are one") with Colossians 1:15-20. How do these passages affirm the divinity of Christ?
- 9. What are some legitimate and illegitimate excuses for not believing in Jesus in our day?
- 10. What does the reality that Jesus offers salvation even to His greatest enemies (those trying to kill Him in this instance) teach us about how we should treat those who are opposed to Christ?
- 11. Verses 40 to 42 contain the last biblical reference to John the Baptist. What is the lasting legacy of his life, and how can we cultivate a similar legacy in our own lives?

○ PROTECT – Care for one another (divided, gender-specific groups)

- 12. In what ways do doubts and fears challenge our trust in God's sovereign hands? How can we help each other overcome them?
- 13. Is there someone in your life who struggles with believing in Jesus? How can our group pray for and support you in sharing the gospel with them?

End by praying for each other—specifically that we would rest in the security of Christ and boldly share our faith with those who need to hear.
